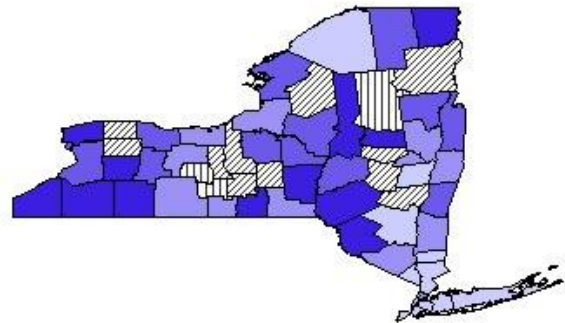
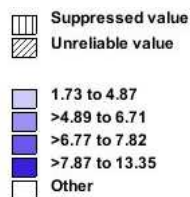




New York State Gun Death Data Years 2012-2016

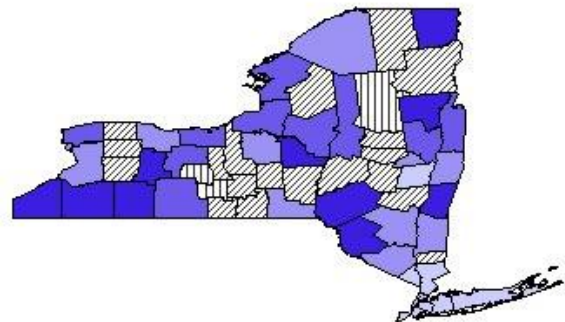
Gun Death Rate in New York

The gun death rate in New York varies greatly across the state. New York County has the lowest gun death rate (average 1.73 deaths per 100,000) and Delaware County has the highest (average 13.35 deaths per 100,000).



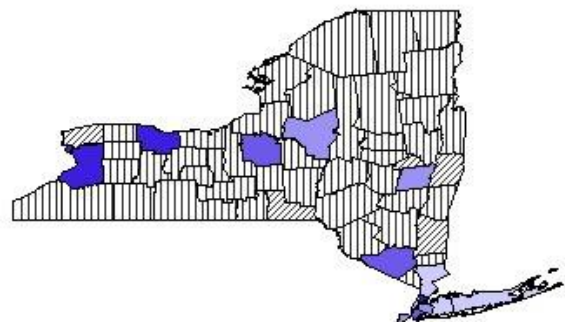
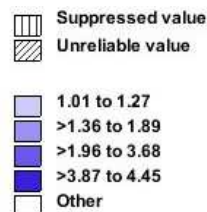
Gun Suicide Rate in New York

New York County has the lowest gun suicide rate (average 0.45 deaths per 100,000) and Delaware County has the highest (average 12.92 deaths per 100,000).

Westchester County has the lowest gun homicide rate (average 1.01 deaths per 100,000) and Erie County has the highest (average 4.45 deaths per 100,000).
